Applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021.**

5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, 1st Floor, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, SM4 5DX by **5pm on Thursday 6 May 2021**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021.
